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advises any clergyman to be teetotal. He simply offers an example. He says—

'Let us go forth 'mong men, not mailed in scorn,
But in the armour of a pure intent;
Great duties are before us, and great songs,
And whether crowned or crownless, when we fall
It matters not, so as God's work be done.'

But Dr. Pereira touches more than the heart of his subject. His book is a convenient and competent guide to every part of it.
