shalt be called by a new name which the mouth of the Lord will name'. It seems to me probable that this passage suggested—either to the priest Mattathias or to some one else—the idea of forming a name מִשְׁכֵּיָהוּ 'the naming of the Lord', in imitation of such well-known names as מַתְּנֵיָהוּ 'the gift of the Lord', מַעֲשֵׂיָהוּ 'the work of the Lord', and others. The name מִשְׁכֵּיָהוּ, when once it was formed, might easily be shortened into מִשְׁכֵּי, just as מַתְּנֵיָהוּ is shortened into מַתְּנֵי (Ezra x 33 37, Neh. xii 19), and מַעֲשֵׂיָהוּ into מַעֲשֵׂי (1 Chron. ix 12).
