In D. W. B. Somerset, “Walter Ker and the ‘Sweet Singers’”, *SRSHJ*, Vol. 2 (2012), pp. 85-108, we stated that Alexander Montgomery or Menteith, one of the four Gibbites who were transported to New Jersey, disappeared from the record after being indentured to Thomas Gordon on arrival in 1684. We conjectured that Montgomery had either died or moved away (pp. 100, 102). We have now found that he returned to Bo’ness in Scotland where he was living in 1691; see *The Ravished Maid in the Wilderness* (n.p., 1708), pp. 19, 23; and D. W. B.
